駅伝コースとなる国道1号(早川口付近から箱根山間部を経て芦ノ湖フィニッシュ付近までの区間)は、例年交通規制のない対向車線も見物渋滞が発生しております。旅館等に宿泊される方、初詣に行かれる方、通過交通の車両利用の皆様にはご不便をおかけしますが、山間部の交通量の抑制にご協力をお願いいたします。

なお、選手の通過に際しては一時的な交通規制も行われます。開催時間帯を避けて通行するよう重ねてお願いいたします。**う回路として、箱根新道(無料)を通行していただくか、有料道路の箱根ターンパイク(普通車730円など)のご利用もご検討ください。**

Request on cheering for Hakone Ekiden

Hakone Ekiden has been fostered by people cheering on runners along the course. We hope the road relay race will be treasured by all of you for many years to come.



- Please refrain from cheering and viewing the race at the starting post and finish line as well as along its course at the 97th event. Please cheer and view the race on TV.
- Cheering by university officials and other parties concerned is prohibited as is the distribution of college newspapers. We ask for your kind cooperation.
- Please refrain from on-site cheering and viewing by university graduates and families of runners as well. Please do cooperate in keeping proper manners for the race.

Matters prohibited

- The act of roping banners, flags, etc. to guardrails, bridges and other public structures along the course, against the Road Traffic Act.
- Cheering aboard vehicles such as cars, motorcycles and bicycles is dangerous and causes traffic jams.
- Operating unmanned airborne objects (radio-controlled vehicles and drones) or using selfie sticks in the neighborhood of the course is banned.
- Events (such as public viewing on a large-screen monitors, sales of programs and goods, and establishment of food stalls) will not take place at the starting post/finish line in Otemachi and near Ashinoko (Lake Ashi). Please refrain from going there as entry to the neighborhood may be restricted.
- Programs and goods will not be sold at any relay point.
- Extra editions will not be distributed in the Ashinoko area on Jan. 2 and in the Otemachi area on Jan. 3.
- The Yomiuri Shimbun and Hochi Shimbun will not hand out small flags for cheering.
